Introduction

- 1. Those who are <u>spiritual</u> look differently at life
- 2. What excites the world makes believers groan
- 3. There is plenty in the UK to make us groan

1. THERE ARE TIMES WHEN GOD'S PEOPLE ARE WEARY

- 1) What is this <u>weariness</u>?
 - (i) heaviness of soul because there is no blessing
 - (ii) a gloomy feeling that we shall see no good
 - (iii)a sadness settling on the soul // incubus

<u>ILLUSTRATION</u>: Peden's sigh: "O to be with Ritchie!"

- 2) Examples from God's Word:
 - (i) Israel in the desert
 - (ii) Christ: "O faithless generation..."
 - (iii)Paul: "Be not weary in well-doing..."
- 3) The <u>effects</u> of this weariness:
 - (i) to slacken in our service to God
 - (ii) to lose heart + to give up
 - (iii)to long for death and deliverance

<u>APPLICATION</u>: Such times there are (Moses / Jeremiah...)

2. AT SUCH TIMES GOD IS ABLE TO SEND BLESSING

- 1) The meaning:
 - (i) a timely intervention to lift our hearts up

- (ii) a sudden alteration to give blessing
- (iii)an unlooked for, sovereign intervention by God
- 2) How described:
 - (i) a shower of rain
 - (ii) which alters everything for the better
 - (iii) and turns away our sighs and groans
- 3) God may allow His people to be at their wits' end before this refreshing comes:
 - (i) Exx. from scripture: Abraham; Joseph; Jeremiah
 - (ii) Exx. from history: Constantine; Luther; Korea
- 4) Why does God allow us to go so far down?
 - (i) to test our faith in His power + promises
 - (ii) to show that it is His work, not man's

ILLUSTRATION: Israel hemmed in by the Red Sea

5) Our faith must "hope against hope".

APPLICATION: At weary times

- (i) remind yourself of God's promises
- (ii) plead them with God

3. THE EFFECT IS TO REFRESH GOD'S WEARY PEOPLE

- 1) There are <u>texts to show</u> this:
 - (i) Hannah's prayer: "No more sad"
 - (ii) Ps. 137 with 126: "As men that dream"!
 - (iii)Simeon, Anna, Mary: "them of low degree"
 - (iv) The two on the way to Emmaus
 - (v) The sight of Christ raised from the dead <u>APPLICATION</u>: How often the face of things looks bad for God's cause and then!
- 2) Revival is God's way of refreshing His people:
 - (i) Pentecost: "suddenly..."
 - (ii) Brainerd with North American Indians

(iii)"Out of weakness – made strong"!

APPLICATION:

- 1. In a weary time do not give up
- 2. The duty is to pray on and work on
- 3. Be patient with yourself and with all others.
