"THE BAPTISM OF CHRIST"

Introduction

- 1. Here we have Christ's baptism
- 2. All is wonder: birth baptism death
- 3. It is all necessary to save us

1. CHRIST WAS BAPTIZED BEFORE HE BEGAN HIS MINISTRY

- 1) Two parts to Christ's life
 - (i) private
 - (ii) public

OBSERVE: He was a "polished shaft" (Isaiah 49) **APPLICATION**: Preachers need as a rule to prepare

- 2) John the Baptist at the <u>height</u> of his ministry
 - (i) his work was to "prepare" for Christ
 - (ii) his preaching was an awakening call

ILLUSTRATION: "a voice crying..." (Isaiah 40)

- (iii)John's baptism for repentance
- (iv)the effect was <u>nation-wide</u>: Matthew 3:5
- (v) and discriminating: the Pharisees
- 3) John's <u>first reaction</u> to Christ's request:
 - (i) he is shocked: Christ's majesty + perfection
 - (ii) Baptism is for sinners how do we explain? **ANSWER**: Christ is sinless but our sin-bearer

2. THE BAPTISM OF CHRIST IS FULL OF MEANING

- 1) It was to "fulfil all righteousness". (Expl.)
- 2) The possible <u>mode</u> of baptism NOT known
- 3) Three wonders at this Baptism:
 - (i) The heavens opened to Him:
 - this was where Christ had come from
 - this was where soon He would return
 - this is where His people would be <u>APPLICATION</u>: What comfort to our Lord – and to us!
 - (ii) The Spirit came down as a dove onto Christ
 - a dove: symbol of gentleness and peace
 - a joint-ministry of Son and Spirit
 - <u>John</u> saw and knew its significance **APPLICATION**: Christian faith makes us peaceable
 - (iii)The Voice of the Father
 - here and at the <u>Transfiguration</u>
 <u>APPLICATION</u>: Let us remember the <u>love</u> of these Persons

3. THESE ARE COMFORTING LESSONS FOR CHRISTIANS HERE

- 1) <u>Baptism</u> is an ordinance of God the sacraments are for our comfort.
- 2) <u>Our service to Christ</u> makes us feel, like John, our utter unworthiness, but it is acceptable.
- 3) The <u>Trinity</u> said, "Let us make man". Here they virtually say, "Let us <u>save</u>".

4) The <u>Voice of God</u> was heard at Sinai. Here at Jordan: Law and Gospel.

OBSERVE: God's order: Law first. to awaken.

5) The love of the divine <u>Persons</u> is a lesson to us all as believers.

CONCLUSION

- 1. O what comfort! Christ is baptized so as to answer for my sins!
- 2. Our <u>baptism</u> is a dying and rising in Him to eternal life.
