### 1. THE PRIME TASK OF THE CHURCH IS TO PREACH

- 1) What we are to Preach: "the word": the 3 R's;
  - (i) the RUIN: the tragic condition of mankind
  - (ii) the <u>REDEMPTION</u>: the power of Christ's blood
  - (iii) the REGENERATION: the Spirit's work of power <u>OBSERVE</u>: Preaching which <u>fails</u> here is worthless
- 2) The Urgency of the Task: "I charge thee"
  - (i) the apostolic command: v.1
  - (ii) the divine Witnesses to our preaching: v.1
  - (iii) the persons and what they all face: v.1

**OBSERVE**: What <u>duty</u> could compare with this?

- 3) See how we ought to measure our life here:
  - (i) "judge"
  - (ii) "quick and dead"

**APPLICATION**: O let us be <u>urgent</u> Christians!

# 2. THERE WILL BE AGES WHEN OUR MESSAGE WILL BE WELCOME – AND WHEN NOT WELCOME

- 1) "<u>In season out of season</u>": v.2
  - (i) Times of blessing + <u>revival</u>: Exx.
  - (ii) Times of deadness + coldness
- 2) Factors which explain the deadness:
  - (i) "will not endure...": v.3. Why not?
  - (ii) "lusts": v.3

- (iii) "itching ears": v.3
- 3) The disastrous state which results:
  - (i) Men "turn away their ears"
  - (ii) "turned unto fables"
- 4) Paul <u>prophesies</u> here what we must expect:
  - (i) Times of <u>blessing</u>: "in season"
  - (ii) Times of declension: "out of season"
- 5) However, our duty remains clear:
  - (i) To preach the whole counsel of God#
  - (ii) Never to depart from the rule of scripture

<u>APPLICATION</u>: Do not be taken in by "seeker friendly" Christianity – the <u>price</u> to pay is too high.

## 3. THE KIND OF PREACHING WE ARE COMMANDED TO GIVE: 3:15-17

- 1) Men need to become:
  - (i) wise
  - (ii) saved
- 2) The <u>way</u> to salvation is by "faith in Christ Jesus"
- 3) **OBSERVE**: <u>Justification</u> is absolutely crucial. Explain.
- 4) "<u>All scripture</u>" = the Bible everywhere
- 5) There are various emphases:
  - (i) doctrine: the Christian's creed
  - (ii) reproof: admonish where they go wrong
  - (iii) correction: putting life + creed right
  - (iv) instruction: practical application

 $\underline{\textbf{APPLICATION}}$ : Do not be  $\underline{\textbf{offended}}$  by these aspects of the preacher's work.
