"THE BLESSINGS OF SALVATION"

Introduction

- 1. Everyone wants a <u>happy</u> life.
- 2. The <u>question</u> is: "How can I get it?"
- 3. The <u>Bible</u> is given to show us the answer.

1. THE ONLY START TO A BLESSED LIFE: v.1-5

- 1) It begins with this: forgiveness from God: v.1
- 2) It has these <u>2 aspects</u> to it:
 - (i) <u>imputation</u>: v.2
 - (ii) a guileless soul: v.2

OBSERVE: Justification and Sanctification

- 3) The way to have a miserable life: v.4
 - (i) he was aware of his guilt
 - (ii) but was not confessing his sin yet
- 4) The way to get the <u>blessed</u> life: v.5
 - (i) confession
 - (ii) forgiveness

APPLICATION: The conscience must be at peace

2. THE BLESSINGS WHICH FOLLOW THE GODLY: v.6-10

- 1) God is listening to their <u>prayers</u>: v.6
- 2) Troubles do not overwhelm him: v.6
- 3) God is <u>hiding-place</u> to him: v.7

 <u>ILLUSTRATION</u>: David persecuted by Saul
- 4) God guides and directs his steps in life: v.8 **APPLICATION**: Do you not want God's help?

- 5) The godly are not to be <u>stubborn</u>: v.9
- 6) God's <u>dealings</u> with the righteous are the reverse to the wicked: v.10 **APPLICATION**: Is not all this true to <u>experience</u>?

3. THE PEOPLE OF GOD ARE A HAPPY PEOPLE: v.11

- 1) God's people are a blessed people: v.11
- 2) They should sing God's praises loudly
- 3) Give the impression of <u>happiness</u> **APPLICATION**: Do not be depressed!
- 4) God commands us to be glad, cheerful:
 - (i) we are saved
 - (ii) we have blessed experiences
 - (iii) we have a blessed hope

<u>APPLICATION</u>: It is our duty to promote love and <u>happiness</u> among one another
