Introduction

- 1. What is <u>important</u> in any church/denomination?
- 2. Possible answers: numbers / friendships / truth
- 3. The picture here is: building a temple

1. THE FOUNDATION IS THE FIRST CONCERN

- 1) v.10: the foundation must be Christ
- 2) An <u>innocent</u> interpretation: church <u>members</u>
 <u>**OBSERVE**</u>: This is a <u>truth</u>; but not the truth here
- 3) The <u>correct</u> interpretation: <u>doctrine</u> concerning Christ (Explain)
- 4) There is no church if no foundation:
 - (i) Liberal "Jesus"
 - (ii) R.C. view (Luther)
- 5) Vital aspects:
 - (i) Godhood
 - (ii) True Manhood
 - (iii) Propitiation
 - (iv) Intercession
 - (v) Coming again

2. WHAT THE MINISTERS OF A CHURCH TEACH IS VITAL

- 1) The illustration of a temple: the different materials used: good / poor
- 2) The <u>meaning</u>: the <u>doctrines</u> which any man preaches
- 3) Truth:
 - (i) may be mixed with <u>error</u>
 - (ii) only partly expressed

(iii) <u>fully</u> and consistently stated:

ILLUSTRATION

- i. God's sovereignty + man's duty
- ii. Legalism + Antinomianism
- 4) <u>Faithfulness</u> varies from preacher to preacher

APPLICATION: Certain emphases are <u>played down</u> today:

- (i) reverence for God in public worship
- (ii) the biblical emphasis on sin
- (iii) the seriousness of a state of death
- (iv) the absolute necessity of a $\underline{\text{New Birth}}$

<u>ILLUSTRATION</u>: Funeral services as "celebrations of life"

– a new + false theology

3. THE REASON WHY ANY PREACHER NEEDS TO BE CONCERNED ABOUT HIS TEACHING

1) Every man's teaching will be <u>tried</u>: <u>**ILLUSTRATION**</u>: a trial by fire

- 2) On the Judgement Day
- 3) A <u>converted</u> preacher's experience:
 - (i) if faithful: a reward
 - (ii) if partly unfaithful: <u>loss</u>

OBSERVE: He will be saved - but will lose some of his

eternal <u>reward</u>

<u>ILLUSTRATION</u>: a man whose house goes on fire – loses

property, not his own life!
