1. THE REASON WHY CHURCHES DECLINE

- 1) The <u>first</u> picture: God's rich grace:
 - (i) v.7-10: God's electing <u>love</u>
 - (ii) v.11-14: gracious dealings

OBSERVE: True of OT and NT church

- 2) The second picture: rebellion
 - (i) v.15-16: pride, worldliness, ingratitude
 - (ii) v.17-18: changed religion

<u>OBSERVE</u>: See the <u>alteration</u>! How great! <u>APPLICATION</u>: Do we <u>appreciate</u> it?

2. EVEN IN DECLENSION THERE IS HOPE

- 1) God's attitude at first:
 - (i) v.19-20: offended love is jealous
 - (ii) v.21-26: all manner of evils

OBSERVE: It is a terrible thing to provoke God

- 2) God's attitude next:
 - (i) v.27: a <u>new</u> dimension change
 - (ii) v.30-31: the <u>root</u> cause of our trouble **OBSERVE**: God has brought this about
- 3) All false religion is <u>deadly</u>:
 - (i) v.31: no god like our God!
 - (ii) v.32-33: false religion is cruel

(iii) v.35-35: <u>God</u> Himself is our hope **APPLICATION**: O it is <u>still</u> true!

3. OUR DECLENSION IS A DISGRACE TO US

- 1) v.36: Here is our <u>Hope</u> of revival
- 2) v.37-38: God <u>taunts</u> his people **OBSERVE**: O what fools we have been!
- 3) What has <u>led</u> to all this?
 - (i) <u>pride</u>: our <u>students</u> to Germany
 - (ii) loss of truth: Bible / Christ / God
 - (iii) decline in holiness
 - (iv) <u>ignorant</u> preaching + worship <u>APPLICATION</u>: Let us <u>feel</u> our disgrace

4. <u>DECLENSION MUST STIR US TO PRAY</u>

1) Our <u>hope</u> is here: v.36 (Explain)

2) It is when our "power is gone"

- (i) few conversions
- (ii) shortage of preachers
- (iii) aging congregations...
- 3) But God is the same!
 - (i) v.39: God's power is glorious
 - (ii) He can scatter the enemies
 - (iii) He can retrace the joy (v.43)

APPLICATION: O! who is praying for this?
