Introduction

- 1. Harvest Thanksgiving it is good
- 2. Let us truly thank God
- 3. Every leaf / grain of food is God's gift to us

1. THE HARVEST OF NATURE

- 1) A wonderful <u>process</u>: sowing / reaping
- 2) Seen in <u>all</u> of nature
- 3) Acknowledged with thankfulness in the O.T.
- 4) It gives glory to <u>God</u>:
 - (i) a process <u>created</u> by Him
 - (ii) providentially cared for by Him
 - (iii) enjoyed by us

APPLICATION: Let us be <u>grateful</u> + see God's hand in it.

2. THE HARVEST OF NATIONS

1) The <u>moral</u> aspect: sowing + reaping

2) It has a message for individuals

- 3) Also for nations:
 - (i) relevant to the <u>UK</u> just now
 - (ii) look back to the old nations
 - (iii) a pattern: rise / wealth / decay
 - (iv) godliness: the "wealth of nations"
 - (v) sin: the same way down
- 4) A sober look at the UK

APPLICATION: "When nations are to perish..."

Let us hide in Christ.

3. THE HARVEST OF LOST SOULS

1) The teaching of scripture: each one of us

2) The way we live has consequences:

- (i) "as we sow, we reap..."
- (ii) "be sure your sin..."
- 3) The picture of a <u>harvest</u> in the end: See Rev.
- 4) The angels will gather them up for the <u>fire</u>
- 5) We cannot see the lost without pity and <u>concern</u> **APPLICATION**: Christ and Jerusalem

4. THE HARVEST OF ALL BELIEVERS

- 1) The same <u>principle</u>: sow / reap
- 2) What are we to <u>sow</u>?
- 3) What <u>harvest</u> will there be?
 - (i) earthly fruit first
 - (ii) heavenly fruit at Judgement
 - (iii) eternal fruit: "with the Lord"

OBSERVE: The great <u>double</u>-harvest here.

APPLICATION: It is not in vain to hold on your way.
