Introduction

- 1. About 8 times: "The Lord". What a God!
- 2. God can make sinners into saints!
- 3. Just as he can make a barren woman bear

1. HOW GOD SEES ALL OF US BEFORE CONVERSION

- 1) v.7: "poor...dust...needy...dunghill"
 - (i) one reason the Bible is scorned: it humbles us
 - (ii) this is the condition we are all in: Psalm 51
 - (iii) so God sees us not a pleasant sight **ILLUSTRATION:** A lady in a coach – curtains **OBSERVE**: God does not close his eyes (v.4-6)
- 2) O let us believe what God here says:
 - "poor": no righteousness / no Father / no wisdom / no light / (i) no hope / no wealth
 - "dust": bits of cloth to wear / sticks are our homes / bits of (ii) paper our money...
 - (iii) "dunghill": a sinful world men live hardly better than the beasts.

ILLUSTRATION: pigs in Mexico **APPLICATION:** God sees mankind in this way

HOW GOD "LIFTS" US UP BY THE GOSPEL 2.

- 1) v.7: "raises up" / "lifts" **OBSERVE**: God does this by his saving grace
- 2) God has many times done this in wonderful love and kindness:
 - David: see his life (i)
 - (ii) The apostles: Peter, etc look at them
 - (iii) The gospels: Bartimaeus, etc
 - (iv) Famous Christians: Bunyan, etc. **DOCTRINE**: Do not despise the poor who believe in Christ

- God "lifts" us in this way: 3)
 - (i) he opens our eyes spiritually to see our need ILLUSTRATION: Legion
 - (ii) he points our eyes upward to heaven
 - (iii) he shows us Jesus Christ as the Way
 - (iv) he gives us faith and repentance **ILLUSTRATION:** Dunkie Donaldson APPLICATION: God can change every one of us!

WHAT GOD WILL DO FOR ALL BELIEVERS AT LAST 3.

- 1) v.8: "set us with princes...of his people".
- Who are these princes? The saints of God: 2)
 - (i) <u>Abraham</u> recall the case of Lazarus
 - (ii) Israel = "a prince with God"
 - (iii) They sit at last on thrones: Rev.
 - (iv) They have crowns of glory
 - (v) They are <u>near</u> to God and to Christ
 - (vi) By adoption, as God's sons
 - (vii) Their home is a palace of glory
- Why does God do this for "beggars"? 3)
 - (i) to display His love and goodness
 - (ii) to confound all earthly wisdom
 - (iii) that it may redound to His glory Look at this: "It doth not appear...shall be" **APPLICATION:** Here's your chance to be a prince!
