"CHRIST'S SECOND COMING"

Introduction

- 1. The gospel enables us to face the <u>future</u>
- 2. Very serious events lie ahead
- 3. We need Christ's help to face them

Theme: The Second coming of Christ

1. THE WAY TO THINK OF BELIEVERS WHO DIE

- 1) v.13: It is <u>important</u> to know this clearly:
 - (i) "asleep" here: How to interpret it

OBSERVE: Christ uses this term also: Examples

- (ii) what we mean by the "<u>Intermediate State</u>" **OBSERVE**: Christians, but no others, have hope"
- 2) v.14: The <u>basis</u> of this hope:
 - (i) the doctrine of the Cross and Resurrection
 - (ii) believers now are "in Jesus". Explain
 - (iii) "asleep in Jesus" a blessed state
- 3) The blessed dead: God "will bring":
 - (i) their bodies to be changed
 - (ii) the <u>nature</u> of this change

APPLICATION: Our comfort

2. THE CONDITION OF BELIEVERS WHEN CHRIST COMES

- 1) A subject on which God has spoken:
 - (i) v.15: "by the word of the Lord"
 - (ii) then will be believers when He comes.
 - (iii) These will not enter glory first
- 2) The divinely-appointed order: v.16-17
 - (i) Christ's descant from heaven
 - (ii) the <u>dead</u> in Christ to rise first

- (iii) the <u>living</u> in Christ to rise next
- (iv) both to be forever with Christ
- 3) <u>Summary</u> of our various states, etc:
 - (i) the <u>living</u> believer: why he dies
 - (ii) the <u>dead</u> believer: perfect, not complete
 - (iii) funeral: biblical method is by burial
 - (iv) the <u>conduct</u> proper: sorrow, but in <u>hope</u>
 - (v) <u>funeral</u>: not a "celebration of a life"
 - (vi) the <u>resurrected</u> believer: complete <u>**TEXTS**</u>: 2 Cor. 5:1f; 1 Cor. 15
 - (vii) the eternal state of glory

APPLICATION: This is profound comfort (v.18)

3. THE CONDITION OF ALL UNBELIEVERS THEN

- 1) The difference not obvious now but will be:
 - i) both have ups and downs in life
 - (ii) both have death to face + go through
- 2) But there is complete <u>difference</u> at death:
 - i) the soul of the believer goes <u>up</u>
 - (ii) the soul of the unbeliever goes <u>down</u>
 <u>OBSERVE</u>: <u>Christ's</u> teaching in Luke 16
- 3) Paul describes the <u>End</u> of the Unconverted:
 - (i) v.3: they <u>flatter</u> themselves
 - (ii) v.3: "sudden destruction"
 - (iii) v.3: no escape possible: ILLUSTRATION: a woman
- 4) The great <u>lesson</u> from all this:
 - (i) v.6: "let us not sleep"
 - (ii) v.9-10: look at the difference!
