"THE VIRTUOUS WOMAN"

Introduction

- 1. A beautiful conclusion to Proverbs
- 2. Often, the wrong women are praised
- 3. Here, it is the godly woman only

1. GOD HERE PRAISES THE VIRTUOUS WOMAN

- 1) Why should God do this?
 - i) Because few do so in this life
 - ii) A godly woman is great treasure on earth
 - iii) Worldly minds praise beauty, not virtue
 - iv) She is a great <u>blessing</u> to all around her **OBSERVE**
 - i) The Bible shows examples: the six Marys
 - ii) History shows them: Wesleys, Mary Winslow
- 2) It is clear: God would have spiritually-minded women to be honoured + respected

2. THIS IS AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE TO THE YOUNG

- 1) The worldly attitude is all wrong we need to get back to the <u>biblical</u> teaching:
 - i) how important to be a godly woman
 - ii) when unmarried to be faithful to God
 - iii) when married to be a good <u>mother</u> **OBSERVE**: "Behind every good man..."
- 2) This biblical teaching is for men too:
 - i) <u>pray</u> for a good + godly wife <u>ILLUSTRATION</u>: comment about <u>preachers'</u> wives
 - ii) "It is not good that the man...alone"

 OBSERVE: To forbid marriage is Satanic See 1 Tim. 4:1-3;
 Heb. 13:4

<u>APPLICATION</u>: Marry a wife who fears the <u>Lord</u> and puts Him first in her life: TEXT

3. A WOMAN'S WORK IS NORMALLY BASED ON HER HOME AND HER FAMILY

- 1) There are some things God <u>forbids</u>: 1 Cor. 14:34; 1 Tim. 2:11-12 **OBSERVE**: This is <u>God's</u> word, not man's
- 2) There is a divine <u>order</u> in marriage: 1 Cor. 11:3-10 **OBSERVE**: This is not <u>tyranny</u>
- 3) The woman is the <u>centre</u> of the home: Titus 2:4-5
- 4) The strength of the family-unit is very much related to the mother's role as the centre of the home. So:
 - i) <u>father</u> is normally bread-winner
 - ii) mother is his help-meet

<u>**OBSERVE**</u>: Mother's role is <u>critical</u> in society and vital to the salvation of the children

Q. Is this not what our society needs?

4. A VIRTUOUS WOMAN IS A HOME-MAKER

- 1) See here: v.14-19. See also Proverbs 14:1
- 2) Here concern for her <u>husband</u>: v.23
- 3) Here children also: v.27. 28-29
- 4) A good <u>home</u> is a place where:
 - i) father leads: family-worship, etc.
 - ii) mother supports: as "help-meet"

OBSERVE: Each role is vital

5) In a word: all pull together to this one end: to glorify God in the home-and to train up the children for God
