1. THE SOWER – WHAT IS HE?

- 1) a minister of Christ's gospel: Romans 10:13-15
- 2) <u>not</u> every preacher:
 - i) loves the truth
 - ii) loves souls
- 3) he must be
 - i) converted
 - ii) sound // God's word

APPLICATION: Do not be gullible about preachers

2. THE SEED – WHAT IS IT?

- 1) The truth of Christ's gospel
- 2) Essential:
 - i) man's heart
 - ii) need
 - iii) God's remedy

<u>ILLUSTRATION</u>: "There are <u>no</u> sinners here"!

3. THE ACT OF SOWING

- 1) explaining the truth of God re. <u>salvation</u>
- 2) Christ is the gospel first and last

3) Our part: to repent and believe

<u>ILLUSTRATION</u>: The preaching of John, Christ, Peter <u>OBSERVE</u>: The preacher's responsibility is to tell the people the truth – he cannot convert

4. THE FOUR KINDS OF GROUND

- 1) "<u>Wayside</u>": v.19
 - i) no understanding some go away as <u>ignorant</u> as they came
 - ii) Satan who and what he is
 - iii) "catcheth away": <u>distractions</u> for their minds; no fear of God

<u>ILLUSTRATION</u>: OT King who burnt it

OBSERVE: "Gospel-hardened". "The sun that melts the butter hardens the clay"

<u>ILLUSTRATION</u>: Dog in blacksmiths forge **APPLICATION**: Pray you may not be so

- 2) "Stony places": shallow hearer:
 - i) very excited at first and for a time

<u>**ILLUSTRATION**</u>: wants to <u>rush</u> into church membership. For a while goes to every meeting, but...

EXAMPLE: Demas, apparently.

- ii) upset by the <u>problems</u>: "tribulation..."

 This is one reason why God allows problems to test the genuineness of our faith
- iii) not a real believer "no root" = "<u>saving</u> faith" Cp. notional faith <u>APPLICATION</u>: Make sure you are <u>real</u>
- 3) "Among Thorns": worldly hearer
 - i) A promising \underline{start} but never truly saved
 - ii) caught up with worldly cares and money

Q. "Deceitfulness? Why? Displace God.

<u>ILLUSTRATION</u>: John 6 – what a disappointment!

APPLICATION: Don't be deceived

- 4) "Good Ground": really converted
 - i) "understand": see its relevance to them
 - ii) "<u>first</u>": godliness / faithfulness / help forward the work of God / evangelise

iii) some more than others: 30/60/100

OBSERVE:

- ♦ some believers more <u>spiritual</u>
- some will be <u>higher</u> in heaven

<u>ILLUSTRATION</u>: Whitfield re Wesley

APPLICATION: Each esteem others more highly
